Divided into five WOC (Wine O'Clock) sales over five consecutive days of online auctions, the sale brought together a unique spectrum of the finest examples of wines and champagnes, among the most sought after in the world. The lots offered included a unique selection of internationally renowned vintages from the greatest houses and vineyards. Burgundy and Bordeaux wines, in particular, generated significant interest, resulting in intense competition among bidders.

The star-lot of the WOC #83 sale on September 17, an assortment of 18 bottles from Domaine de la Romanée-Conti 2017, was sold for CHF 56'120, shattering its low estimate of CHF 36'000.

An overall sale rate of 80% of the lots offered.

Several highlight lots, including rare vintages of Romanée-Conti and Château Pétrus, reached record prices.

A total of nearly CHF 1.4 million was achieved across the entire sale, confirming the strength of the fine wine market and the enthusiasm of collectors for bottles with impeccable provenance.
